1. Main Contents and Activities 주요내용 및 활동

- 제45차 기후변화에 관한 정부간 협의체(IPCC) 총회에 정부대표단으로 참석
- 총회에서 논의된 의제 분석 및 대응 지원
- ‘외부 자원 동원’ 의제와 관련하여 정부대표단 발언문 작성 지원
- ‘영향 및 기후 분석을 위한 자료 및 시나리오 지원에 관한 태스크그룹(TGICA)’ 의제 및 ‘해양 및 빙권에 관한 특별보고서 개요’ 의제와 관련하여 집중적인 분석을 수행하고 전문 작성 등 지원

2. Relevance to APEC Climate Center's Activities 결론 및 소감

○ (해양 및 빙권 특별보고서) 많은 회원국들이 식량안보 차원의 수산업 및 원격 상관 문제 등과 기후변화의 영향에 대한 해결방안 모색 필요성 등에 공감하였음. 블루카본 내용을 보고서에 포함하는 것에 대해서는 각국의 의견이 일치하지 않았지만, 새로운 감축 옵션으로서의 중요성이 인정되어 원안대로 보고서 내용에 포함됨.

- 저지대국가 및 도서국가들은 해수면상승 및 산호초 소실로 인한 주거지 감소를, 고산지역 국가들은 고산지역의 용빙에 의한 수자원 감소와 생태계 변화 영향을 심각하게 우려함.

○ (토지 특별보고서) 산림(forest)관련 내용이 동 보고서의 outline에서 언급됨에 따라 보고서 작성을 위한 산림전문가가 참여할 수 있도록 하고, 사무국에서 각국에 전문가 추천 요청시 반영되도록 지속적 관리가 필요함.

- 동 보고서 집필과 관련하여 UNCCD와의 협력 및 지원 확대가 기대되며, 특히 개도국의 관심이 높은 보고서로, 우리나라를 비롯한 선진국의 경우 적응분야에 우위가 있어 동 보고서의 중요성을 인정하면서도 균형을 맞추는데 초점을 맞추고 진행하고 있음.

○ (IPCC 재정) 제43차 총회부터 제기되어 온 IPCC 재정난에, 새로이 신탁기금을 기여하거나 증액하는 국가가 늘고 있음.

- 외부 자원동원과 관련하여 회원국 기여를 늘려야 한다는 선진국과 외부자원을 동원하되 신중해야 한다는 개도국 간 이견이 있는바, 개도국으로 분류되어 있으나 지속적으로 상당한 기여금을 지불하고 있는 우리나라가 향후 어떻게 대응해야 할지 국내 입장 정리가 필요함.

○ (블랙카본) 다음 총회에서 멕시코의 제안에 대한 추가 논의가 이루어질 예정인 바, 블랙카본을 비롯한 SLCFs의 방법론 산정에 대한 우리나라의 입장을 정해야 할 것으로 사료됨.

○ (AR6) 다음 총회에서는 AR6의 개요 승인이 있을 예정인 바, 기후변화 과학, 적응, 완화와 관련된 모든 정부 부처들의 관심이 요구됨.

Sir/Madam,

I am writing on behalf of the Chair of the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC) on the subject of the Forty-Fifth Session of the IPCC (IPCC-45) scheduled to take place at Hotel Fiesta Americana, Av. Aurelio Aceves No. 225, Glorieta Minerva Col. Vallarta Poniente, Guadalajara, Jalisco, Mexico, from 28 to 31 March 2017. The session will be preceded by a pre-plenary briefing on Monday 27 March (p.m). It is both an honour and pleasure for me to extend the invitation to participate in this session, through you, to your Government. The opening of IPCC-45 will be at 10:00 hours on Tuesday, 28 March 2017.

The main agenda items of the Forty-Fifth Session of the IPCC will be to consider the outline for the IPCC Special Report on Climate Change, oceans and the cryosphere, and the outline for the Special Report on climate change, desertification, land degradation, sustainable land management, food security, and greenhouse gas fluxes in terrestrial ecosystems. The Panel will also address other items that require consideration and decision by the Panel.

Simultaneous interpretation in the official UN languages (Arabic, Chinese, English, French, Russian and Spanish) will be provided during the session. All documentation will be in English only. The provisional agenda of IPCC-45 (IPCC-XLV/Doc.1) as well as other documentation will be posted on the IPCC website www.ipcc.ch as soon as available on a page established for the session. Information about hotel booking, deadlines and visa requirements will also be made available on the IPCC website.

I will be grateful if you would designate the representative(s) of your Government to the session. Allow me to recall that the participation of delegates with appropriate expertise is vital for the success of the meeting. Please communicate the name and affiliation of the representative(s) of your Government in a letter to me at the IPCC Secretariat, c/o World Meteorological Organization, P.O. Box 2300, 7bis Avenue de la Paix, CH-1211 Geneva 2, Switzerland by mail, or attached to an e-mail addressed to ipcc-sec@wmo.int by **Friday 17 February 2017**. Nominations by simple e-mail cannot be accepted; as an intergovernmental organization we must receive your nomination(s) under an official letterhead.

Please pre-register each designated participant, no later than Thursday 23 March 2017, at the following website: <http://www.ipcc.ch/register/>. Please use your unique credentials that you have already received for the previous session to access the password-protected site. Should there be a change of the Focal Point, please inform the Secretariat.

Please note that, as per common practice, pre-registered participants will be required to register at the conference venue, and at that point they will receive access to the IPCC papersmart system. Pre-session documentation will not be distributed on paper. The system will allow registered participants to access session documents in electronic format during the meeting on a dedicated web portal via individual credentials linked to their registration.

We strongly encourage participants to bring their computers to the meeting in order to access the papersmart system.

Limited financial support is available from the IPCC Trust Fund to representatives from developing countries and countries with economies in transition, one per country. However, due to the difficult financial situation of the IPCC Trust Fund, they are invited to contact the IPCC Secretariat only if their government cannot cover their travelling costs. Nominations for financial support should reach the IPCC Secretariat no later than **Friday 24 February 2017**. I request that this deadline be strictly adhered to because of the time required for the logistics of delivering the support.

A copy of this letter is being sent for information to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and to the Permanent Representatives from your country to the World Meteorological Organization (WMO) and to the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP).
