2. Relevance to APEC Climate Center's Activities 결론 및 소감

- APEC-funded project "Strengthening APEC Cooperation on Food Security and Climate Change" (PPFS 03 2016A) 의 최종결과물인 APEC Multi-Year Action Plan (MYAP) on Food Security and Climate Change에 대해서 논의함
- MYAP의 전략적인 테마(strategic themes)와 주요 포커스 분야(key areas of focus)를 확정하기 위해 APEC 회원국 대표들로부터의 의견 및 토의를 바탕으로 최종 안 도출함
- MYAP의 대상 분야는 rice, livestock, fishery이고 해당 분야를 중심으로 식량안보 및 기후변화 대응을 위한 다양한 옵션들이 정책, 역량배양, 기술개발, 우수사례를 중심으로 논의됨
- 모든 대상 분야에서 식량안보 및 기후변화 대응을 위해 기후정보서비스(climate information service)의 활용이 중심이 되었으며, APEC기후센터가 정보의 제공 및 가공, 기술협력을 위한 유일한 기관으로 논의됨
- 따라서 본 워크숍을 통해 도출된 APEC MYAP의 최종 안에 APEC기후센터의 역할이 명시될 가능성이 높은 상황이며, 관련해서 최종 안 결정 이전에 전체 공유가 될 예정임
- 이 때 센터 내 공유가 되고 의견수렴 기회가 있을 것임

Dear Dr. Kim,

I am pleased to invite you as a speaker to the second APEC workshop on Strengthening APEC Cooperation on Food Security and Climate Change. The workshop will be held in Ho Chi Minh City, Viet Nam, from 22-23 June 2017.

The workshop is implemented by the United States in close consultation with Viet Nam. It is co-funded by APEC and the U.S.-funded U.S. – APEC Technical Assistance to Advance Regional Integration (US-ATAARI) Project.

As a co-funded project, APEC has agreed to fully cover your travel, accommodations and per diem as a speaker.

In 2016, APEC members approved the APEC-funded project “Strengthening APEC Cooperation on Food Security and Climate Change” (PPFS 03 2016A), which is led by the United States in collaboration with Viet Nam. This project involves two APEC capacity building workshops to be implemented in 2017 with the objective of knowledge sharing and cooperation on food security and climate change to inform the development of the APEC Multi-Year Plan on Food Security and Climate Change. It is anticipated that the final APEC Multi-Year Plan will be ready for Ministerial endorsement by the Food Security Ministerial Meeting in Can Tho, Viet Nam in August 2017.

The first workshop, which was implemented in April 2017, generated recommendations of potential actions that could be further considered for the APEC Multi-Year Plan on Food Security and Climate Change. This second workshop will aim to review and build on the outcomes of the previous workshop by clearly defining the structure and critical actions that will form the basis of the APEC Multi-Year Plan in terms of the strategic themes and key areas of focus. To this end, the second workshop will primarily target participants who can authoritatively discuss concrete actions and opportunities for regional cooperation that should be reflected in the APEC Multi-Year Plan. The first draft on Multi-Year Action plan will be submitted to APEC Members and participants prior to the second workshop.

We are confident that your participation and expertise will be essential in implementing a successful workshop, which will result in defining the overall scope and content of the draft APEC Multi-Year Action Plan.
